Hat/Slipper Day to Help Cystic Fibrosis Foundation

On Monday, February 27, we will help raise money for the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation by doing a hat/slipper day. For a \$1 donation, students may wear a ball cap or other type of hat all day. Students may also wear slippers for an additional \$1 donation. Money can be turned in to teachers that morning. Students in grades 7-12 may choose to wear tennis shoes instead of slippers for the same donation. Cystic Fibrosis is an inherited chronic disease that affects the lungs and digestive system of about 30,000 children and adults in the United States (70,000 worldwide). A defective gene and its protein product causes the body to produce unusually thick, sticky mucus that clogs the lungs and leads to life-threatening lung infections; obstructs the pancreas and stops natural enzymes from helping the body break down and absorb food.
